

Effective July 1, 2011, the Washington County Detention Center (county) was required by law to change the provider of commissary service for the inmates. The county has entered into an agreement with the State of Tennessee to provide this service with one of its blind vendors. In order to place an order, the inmate will have to have money in their account that will be maintained by the blind vendor. **The Washington County Detention Center will have NO responsibility for these funds!** ALL issues will be addressed with TBE.

IN-COMING FUNDS: Family and friends have two options for putting money in an inmate's account.

1. There is a drop box on our front porch for postal money orders or cashier's checks made out to the inmate. An envelope will be provided and must be filled out completely.
2. The postal money orders or cashier checks may also be mailed to the inmate at the following address:
