GREENE COUNTY MAN CHARGED FOLLOWING SCHOOL ZONE TRAFFIC STOP

According to Sheriff Ed Graybeal, a Greene County man was arrested Friday afternoon following a traffic stop in the South Central area of the county.

Isaiah John Wood, age 25, was pulled over by Investigator's after being observed by officers using his cell phone while in a school zone. Following the stop, Investigator's noticed a strong odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle and a K9 dog alerted to the presence of narcotics in the vehicle.

A search of Wood's vehicle revealed approximately 85 grams of marijuana and approximately 2.7 grams of marijuana wax. A set of digital scales were found, large plastic baggies, and a marijuana grinder. During the search, deputies also located several boxes of vape cartridges that were found loaded with approximately 1 gram of liquid that field tested positive for THC.

As a result, Wood was charged with:

- Prohibited Use of Mobile Phone in School Zone
- Possession of Schedule VI Drugs for Resale
- Violation of the Drug Free School Zone Act
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia
- Driving on Suspended License
- Financial Responsibility Law

Wood was booked into the Detention Center Friday afternoon on a \$23,000 bond and will have an appearance in Sessions Court on Monday at 1pm.
