WCSO SEARCHING FOR POSSIBLE DROWING VICTIM ON BOONE LAKE

According to Sheriff Ed Graybeal, on 7-13-2021 at approximately 4:30 am, deputies responded to a report of an abandoned vehicle in the 300 Block of Carroll Creek Rd, which is property adjacent to Boone Lake. Neighbors reported hearing a male in distress and a female telling the male to float on his back. The female was found and arrested on the other side of the lake later that morning.

Over the past three days, multiple agencies which include the Washington County Sheriff's Office, Sullivan County Sheriff's Office Underwater Investigation Team, and Tennessee Wildlife Resource Agency have searched the area using drivers, underwater drones and boats equipped with sonar. On the first day of searching, an article of clothing was found by Investigators which was confirmed to be from the victim.

The female provided statements of the incident to investigators and is cooperating. The missing individual is David Schreck, white male, 32 years of age. He is 6'1" approximaly 200 lbs, brown hair with hazel eyes. No foul play is suspected but WCSO is asking the public to be on the lookout for Shreck and that boaters at Boone Lake to be aware of this case.
